**Comments/Ideas/Notes worth Sharing:**

- Consider creating a private Facebook page\* to keep students engaged. It has been very successful for some instructions. Also a good way to have parents check in. Assign projects, have students post videos, read, sing songs, once a week to keep them actively involved. \*Make sure students have approval to join FB page.
- Assign art project they make with something they find around the house – take pictures and post it
- Consider having students continue to work on their portfolio projects and CDA binders



- Try an “overachiever” circle time Monday – Friday
- Have students post activities on Class DOJO
- Have students brainstorm ideas of what a virtual graduation might look like.
- Assign students put together a project based on age group they pick, find activity on line, describe how to make/do/play the activity and how it is beneficial to that age group.
- Have students do a lesson plan based on a famous artist
- Look for virtual field trips for students to explore and report back
- Try Better Kid Care podcasts through Penn State
- Consider joining the Family and Consumer Science Teachers Facebook page for lots of great resources.
- To motivate seniors with a less work intensive less plan, have them read to a group of preschoolers and videotape session.
- Have students create a book on Book Creator and share with preschool families.
